



Pathway to Employment (Year 1) - Full Time

Course Overview

This programme is designed to meet the needs of people with learning difficulties and/or disabilities who have been (or are currently being) supported by an Education Health and Care Plan, or a support plan within their current provision. The range of difficulties may include students with learning difficulties, communication and emotional difficulties, physical difficulties, mental health difficulties, autism and ADHD. This study programme will offer you the opportunity to improve your Maths and English Skills. In year 1 the focus will be around Independent living Skills, and in year 2 the focus will be on Employability Skills, designed to get students work ready. Units of work will include independent travel training, personal finance, allotment work, communication skills and maintaining a healthy lifestyle. In addition, the second year of this course will include an individually sourced work placement (1 day a week) which will give you the vital experience of the world of work.

What Qualifications Or Experience Do I Need?

There are no entry requirements but you will need to show a keen interest in learning new skills.

How Long Is The Course?

Two Years

What Will I Learn?

As well as developing skills in Maths and English you will learn and put into practice Employability skills during your course including: personal finance, travel training challenge, working as a team and enterprise. You will also be given the opportunity to develop your access skills including reading, handwriting and spelling. There will be discrete opportunities for you to work towards personal objectives to achieve your goals. There will also be an opportunity for you to take part in various community based activities as well as group work experience. In year 2 of the course, you will take part in an individually sourced work placement.

How Will I Learn?

You will learn through participation in engaging sessions, practical activities and community based learning.
